Citizen Science

1. Data administrator

2. Scope of data and purpose of processing

Personal data are processed for the following purposes:

 to collect and process the information sent by email (name and surname, email address)
to publish the data of persons cooperating with the CNE in the implementation of the 'Citizen Science' project (name and surname)

3. Legal basis for data processing

The legal grounds for the processing of personal data are set out in Article 6 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27th April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regards to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repeal of Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) - hereinafter 'GDPR'.

We process your data on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of GDPR - i.e. your consent. Your consent is given by:

Data processing operations carried out before the withdrawal of consent will remain compliant, also following its withdrawal.

4. Voluntary data provision

The provision of data is voluntary.

5. Data recipients

The data (name and surname) of those who have given their consent will be made public on the project website.

Other data will be made available only to entities cooperating with CNE in the area of IT support (e-mail server, network, etc.).

6. Data transfer

Personal data will not be transferred to a third country (outside the European Economic Area), but will be published on the Internet.

7. Data storage period

For the purpose stated in item 2. 1) data will be stored until the end of data collection. For the purpose set out in item 2. 2) data will be stored until you withdraw your consent to data processing.

8. You have the right to request access to your data from CNE, for the purpsose of its correction, erasure

9. Automated decision-making

The data collected are not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

10. Complaints
